

Orbit – Serato DJ Loops, Cues and FX MIDI Map – Installation instructions

Note: Orbit cannot be used standalone with Serato DJ. You are required to have an officially supported Serato DJ controller. For a full list of supported controllers visit <http://serato.com/dj/hardware>

Installation

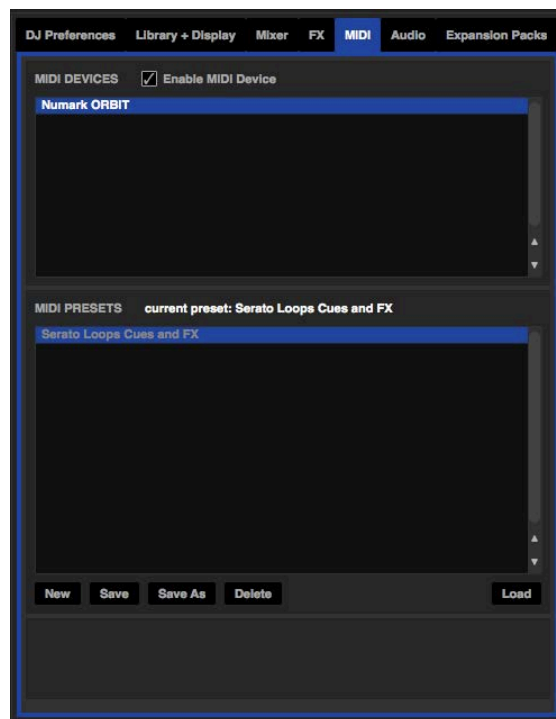
1. Locate the Serato DJ MIDI folder, and place “Serato Loops Cues and FX.XML” inside the XML folder.

Pro-Tip: Serato DJ Default location is usually in the following locations:

Mac: *User > Music > _Serato_ > MIDI > XML*

Windows: *Users> (user name) > My Music > _Serato_ > MIDI > XML*

2. Connect Orbit and your supported Serato controller and start Serato DJ.
3. Click Setup and navigate to the MIDI tab.
4. In the MIDI tab, tick Enable MIDI Device then highlight Numark ORBIT
5. Under MIDI PRESETS select “Serato Loops Cues and FX” then click Load. This will enable the controller and the mapping. Settings should look like the below picture:



Optional Step:

Serato DJ does not support LED for additional devices at this time. If you do not wish to assign colors yourself, you can add the pre-defined colors by using the Numark Orbit MIDI Editor. Load and send the ***Loops and Cues Serato DJ Colors.json*** using the MIDI editor.
